Format	Cadet/Rookie Enduro	- 60 Minute Duration - Watertight Stainless 60
	Junior Enduro	- 90 Minute Duration - Silver Cleaning Systems 90
	Senior Enduro	- 150 Minute Duration - Tas Performance Warehouse 150

Team Info	Cadet/Rookie Enduro	Teams of one Rookie and One Cadet, each driver will use their own Kart. Each driver to complete at least 45% of total duration.
	Junior Enduro	Teams of 2 JNL or 2 JNH. One Kart per team (shared Kart). Each driver to complete at least 45% of total duration. This event will use a laps completed handicap system to determine the event winning team.
	Senior Enduro	Teams of 2 SNL, 2 SNH, 2 SNSH, or 2 O40's drivers. One Kart per team (shared Kart). Each driver to complete at least 45% of total duration. This event will use a laps completed handicap system to determine the event winning team.

Weights	Cadet/Rookie	- As per class weights.
	Junior Enduro	- As per class weights.
	Senior Enduro	- SNL & SNH as per class weights, SNSH @ 170kg, O40 pro weight @ 150kg.

Scrutineering Saturday 3rd October 11:00am – 3.00pm.

All karts must be scrutineered prior to the Enduro, and must conform to the Kart formula and class weights stated above.

Notes for the Enduro's

- An AMB transponder-based timing system will be in place for the enduro events. All karts must have a timing transponder holder fitted.
- There will be an outright winner for each enduro, as well as a 'handicap' winner for the Junior and Senior Enduro.
- The handicap system will be as follows: Juniors – The JNL competitors must lap the JNH drivers twice to be considered in front, i.e. they have a 2 lap handicap. The SNL competitors will have a 3 lap handicap on SNH competitors, a 4 lap handicap on O40 pro competitors and a 6 Lap handicap for SNSH competitors.
- Club/ race officials reserve the right to alter handicaps due to adverse weather conditions, time restrictions and race stoppages. They also have the right to change any aspect of the format as deemed necessary.
- Minimum of 10 teams required for each endurance event or the class will be cancelled.

- Tyres: One set of Dunlop SL1 Dry Tyres and 1 set Dunlop KT6 Wet Tyres per Kart. Tyres to be presented and marked at pre-race scrutineering.
- Fuel Tanks: Cadet/Rookie max tank size of 6.5 Litres. Junior/Senior: max tank size of 9.5 Litres.
- Pit Stops/Driver Changes: Cadet/Rookie – minimum 2 minute stop, Junior/Senior minimum 3 minute stop. Karts/Teams to be tagged in and out.
- All Kart refuelling/repairs must be carried out in Parc Ferme area.
- Pit crew – Maximum of 2 per team and must wear green hi-vis vests at all times. Pit crew allowed one signal board/lollypop in designated area only. No radio/phone communications between karts and pits allowed.
- Karts stopped on track will be recovered and returned to Parc Ferme area. Track will go full course yellow and pace kart and recovery trailer will be used to recover karts. The Pit Lane will be closed during full course yellow, no pit stops allowed.
- Stop/Go penalties will apply for breach of rules/deliberate kart contact etc. To be ordered by the Chief Steward. The driver will be notified via a Penalty Board with kart number displayed. The driver must complete the penalty within two laps. No kart work may be done during this penalty and the penalty cannot be served during full course yellow.
- This is a separate event to the Southern Karting Prix Event on Sunday 4th October.
- See attached 2 Driver entry form for entering this meeting – Only one entry form per team please.
- Full set of enduro procedures and rules will be issued to all team drivers at pre event scrutineering on Saturday 3rd October.
